

Soil pH 6.0 - Start peppers indoors, 6 weeks before the last spring frost. Sow the seeds ¼ inch deep in fine potting soil. Pepper seeds need warm soil to germinate. The best germination rates occur when soil temperature is between 72 to 80 degrees F. Use heating cables or a propagation mat to maintain soil temperature. Seeds will take 10-15 days to germinate. Transplant outside 1-2 weeks after last spring frost.

7047 - ACONCAGUA 75 days - Named after Mt. Aconcagua in Argentina, the pendant shaped, 10½ x 2½" fruits are sweet & crunchy and mature to a beautiful red color. Great for frying!

7014 - BULL NOSE 55-80 days - A prolific variety from India that dates back to 1759. This bell pepper is both hot and sweet - the ribs are very pungent, but the thick flesh is mild and sweet.

75 - CALIFORNIA WONDER 75 days - This large, thick walled, juicy, sweet pepper is the most popular variety grown in the United States today! A delicious, 4" pepper used in salads or for stuffing.

7023 - CHERVENA CHUSHKA 85 days - This sweet and crunchy Bulgarian heirloom was primarily used for roasting, but is also great eaten fresh. The tapered fruits measure 2" at the shoulder by 6" long and ripen from green to brown to a bright red color

71 - GOLDEN SUMMIT 65 days - This old Yugoslavian heirloom has been in cultivation for over 200 years! The light green fruit turns a beautiful gold color, maturing to a bright, deep red. Very sweet!

7021 - GOLDEN TREASURE 80 days - This sweet Italian variety has medium thick flesh and thin skin. The long, two lobed fruits mature to a lovely yellow color. Full of flavor!

PEPPERS (HOT) (Capsicum annuum)

7036 - ANAHEIM CHILI 70-90 days - Heavy bearing 2-2½ foot plants bear plenty of medium-thick fleshed fruits. The 8 x 1½" peppers are moderately pungent and mature to a beautiful red color. Great for drying or frying.

7037 - ANCHO 88-150 days - A favorite Mexican variety! Fat, heart shaped 4 x 3" fruits mature to a red/ brown color and are extremely wrinkled when dry. The mildly hot, distinctive flavor makes this the choice of many.

7033 - BLACK HUNGARIAN 70-80 days - A very attractive heirloom with green foliage, highlighted by purple veins and flowers. The 3 foot plants grow 2-3" fruits that resemble jalapenos. A mildly hot pepper with good flavor!

★ **7049 - ORANGE BELL** 85 days - Crunchy and sweet, this 4x3 inch blocky pepper is excellent for stir-frys or eaten fresh. Delightful on relish trays and salads. Very prolific and a good choice for freezing.

★ **7045 - ORANGE SUN** 90 days - The crunchy, sweet taste of this large, blocky, bell variety makes it a great choice for eating raw or using in stir-frys. The thick-fleshed fruits start out dark green, maturing to a beautiful glossy, orange color.

7009 - SWEET BANANA 65 days - These banana shaped fruits are wonderful either in salads or frying! The 6 inch peppers are sweet and mild, growing on plants that average 20 inches high.

7015 - BIRDSEYE CHILI 90 days - An extremely pungent variety that matures to a bright red color. The compact 1-1½ foot plants grow bushy and are covered with 1" erect fruits. Great for containers!

PEPPERS (HOT) (*Capsicum annuum*)

7041 - BULGARIAN CARROT 65-70 days - A wonderful Bulgarian heirloom that sets bright orange, thin walled, 1½-3½" fruit. The hot, but fruity tasting peppers grow in large clusters close to the main stem on this 1½ foot plant.

7025 - CANDLELIGHT 80 days - The very pretty 12-16" plants are loaded with thin, tapered 1x¼" fruits. The mildly hot peppers grow in clusters of 4-6, and ripen from green to yellow to orange to brilliant red. As ornamental as it is delicious!

7038 - CHILTEPIN 80-95 days - A terrific variety that can be found occasionally growing wild in the southwestern U.S. These small, 1 foot plants have plenty of tiny ¼-½", very hot fruits. A great choice for container growing!

76 - EL CHACO 75 days - This is one hot pepper!! Named after the vast plains in South America near the Paraguay River, the thin, 4 inch slightly curved pods are abundant on this 18" plant. The fruits start off green, turning bright yellow, then maturing to a deep orange-red color.

7011 - GUMDROP 95 days - These bushy, 18 inch plants are filled with little gumdrop-like peppers! 7002 - LARGE HOT CHERRY 85 days - These fiery hot, 1", globe shaped fruits appear on 2 foot plants. They start out green, turning a bright red color at maturity. A very productive pepper for pickling.

7031 - PASILLA BAJIO 75-80 days - An essential in south-of-the-border cuisine! Mildly hot, but slightly sweet, the slender 12" peppers mature to a deep brown color, rendering a rich, unique flavor. The one for flavoring Mexican mole!

7010 - PEPPERONCINI 72 days - The small, very mild peppers are 2-3" x ½" and great used either fresh or pickled. The small, bush plants are originally from southern Italy, and are very finely flavored!

PUMPKINS

Soil pH 6.0 to 7.0 - Sow the seeds after all danger of frost has passed in a sunny location of the garden. Sow 1 inch deep, 4 feet apart, in rows 6 feet apart. Harvest when the skin is hard and can't be easily pierced with your fingernail.

84 - ATLANTIC GIANT (*Cucurbita maxima*) 120 days - This is the one to grow for giant pumpkins! These round pumpkins with bright orange skin can weigh 400 pounds or more!

82 - BIG MAX (*Cucurbita maxima*) 120 days - Huge pumpkins grow 100 pounds or more! The fruits are nearly round, with slightly rough red-orange skin. Good for pies or canning. Great for jack-o-lanterns!

85 - CASPER (*Cucurbita pepo*) 100 days - Great for Halloween jack-o-lanterns! The white skin has a bluish hue, giving it that "spooky" look. Pumpkins are 8-10 inches in diameter and weigh 10-20 pounds.

O88 CHEYENNE BUSH PUMPKIN (*Cucurbita pepo*) 80-90 days A terrific choice for those with a shorter growing season or limited growing space. This early variety delivers high yields of 7 pound fruits on smaller, bush vines.

81 - CONNECTICUT FIELD (*Cucurbita pepo*) 110 days - This old time variety from the early 1800's can weigh 25 pounds or more. Perfect for Halloween jack-o-lanterns. The sweet flesh makes excellent pies!

88 - CORNFIELD PUMPKIN (*Cucurbita pepo*) 90 days - Farmers found this a good choice to grow between their corn crops. The perfectly shaped 10-15 pound fruits are great for pies or jack-o-lanterns. If space is a problem for you, why not borrow this idea?

83 - JACK BE LITTLE (*Cucurbita pepo*) 90 days - These dark orange pumpkins are small enough to fit in the palm of your hand! They grow only about 2" tall by 3" wide. Great for fall table decorations!

89 - MAMMOTH KING (*Cucurbita maxima*) 120 days - This pre-1824 giant can reach 50-100 pounds and has coarse, solid, yellow flesh. The slightly flattened 18-24" globes have a molted yellow-orange color and are faintly ribbed. Great for Autumn decorating!

80 - NEW ENGLAND PIE (*Cucurbita pepo*) 105 days - This bright orange, 5-8 pound pumpkin is ideal for pies. Delicious flavor!

RADISH (*Raphanus sativus*)

Soil pH 5.5 to 7.0 - Sow the seeds 2 to 3 weeks before the last spring frost. Plant ¼ inch deep, 1 inch apart in all directions, in a wide row. Thin to one plant every 1 to 2 inches. Use a row cover to protect from insect damage.

820 - BARTENDER RED MAMMOTH 35 days - Bright, scarlet colored 9" roots, with firm, pungent, pink flesh. Tolerates hot weather.

815 - BLACK SPANISH 55 days - Introduced in 1824, this 3-4" globe shaped winter radish has black skin and white flesh. Good keeper.

814 - BRIGHTEST BREAKFAST 28 days - Introduced in 1870, this oblong 1½ inch radish is scarlet with a white tip. Mild and sweet!

810 - COMET 25 days - "All American Selection" winner in 1936. The bright red skin with white flesh, stays solid in warm weather.

813 - CRIMSON GIANT 30 days - A large, crisp, sweet radish with crimson skin and pure white flesh. A heavy producer.

811 - WHITE ICICLE 28 days - Mild, flavorful, 5-6 inch long radish with crisp white flesh. Stays solid - even when the weather heats up!

RUTABAGA (*Brassica napus*)

Soil pH 6.0 to 6.8 - May be planted 2 to 3 weeks before the last spring frost or in the fall for winter storage. Sow seeds 4 inches apart, going all directions, in a wide row. Thin plants to one every 4 inches. Harvest before the ground freezes.

4030 - AMERICAN PURPLE TOP 80-120 days - The nearly globe shaped roots grow 4-6" in diameter, and have a light yellow skin with a purple top. The flesh is a light yellow color, finely grained and sweet.

4031 - LAURENTAIN 90-122 days - The 5 inch purple topped globes have creamy yellow bottoms and firm, pale yellow flesh. Very uniform; great for fall and winter storage.

SOUTHERN FAVORITES**COLLARDS** (*Brassica oleracea*)

Soil pH 6.0 to 6.5 - Start the seeds outside in mid-spring, planting 2-4 seeds every 6 inches. Thin to one plant every 6 inches. Harvest the outside leaves. Plants will improve their flavor after a light frost.

3001 - GEORGIA 75 days - This old time standard variety has huge cabbage-like, blue-green, lightly crumpled leaves. This non-heading type grows 31" tall and tolerates both heat and poor soil conditions.

3003 - MORRIS HEADING 52-85 days - An old time favorite that's very slow to bolt. The 1½ - 2 foot plants have loose, heavy heads with short stems and smooth dark-green leaves with light green veins.

3002 - VATES 75 days - This non-heading variety has dark green, slick, crumpled leaves on 30 inch plants and is bolt and frost resistant. Winter hardy in southern and mid-Atlantic states.

KALE (*Brassica oleracea*)

Soil pH 6.0 to 6.5 - Start the seeds outside in mid-spring, planting 2-4 seeds every 4 inches. Thin to one plant every 4 inches. Harvest the outside leaves. May also be planted for a fall crop; the flavor will improve after the first fall frost.

3005 - DWARF BLUE CURLED 60 days - This variety grows only 12 to 15 inches, and has finely curled, blue/ green leaves. A good variety for the northern states since it withstands cold weather.

3008 - RUSSIAN RED 55 days - An heirloom favorite of many! The red, frilly leaves with purple veins are oak-leaved shaped and are very tender and tasty. An old variety that dates back to 1885.

MUSTARD GREENS (*Brassica juncea*)

Soil pH 6.0 to 6.5 - Start the seeds outside after the last spring frost, planting 2-4 seeds every 4 inches. Thin to one plant every 4 inches. May also be planted for a fall crop; the flavor will improve after the first fall frost.

3009 - GREEN WAVE 43 days - This "All American Winner" in 1957 does well in all areas of the United States. The dark green, deeply frilled leaves have a spicy, hot flavor. If bolting has been a problem in the past, this is a good choice for you.

3010 - SOUTHERN GIANT CURLED 50 days - This slow-bolting variety is an excellent choice for southern states. The mildly flavored plants grow 18-24 inches, and have large, bright green, curled leaves.

Soil pH 6.0 to 6.5 - Start the seeds outside after the last spring frost, planting 2-4 seeds every 12" in a sunny location. Thin to one plant every 12".

3013 - CLEMSON SPINELESS 60 days - "All American Selection" winner in 1939. The 4 foot plants produce ample amounts of dark green, high quality pods. Best picked when pods are 2½ to 3" long.

3017 - RED BURGUNDY 60 days - These attractive 4 foot plants yield delicious, tender, 6-8" burgundy pods! Has green leaves, but burgundy stems, branches and leaf ribs. A very unique variety!
