The lost wax process means that for every component in a finished door knob or plumbing fitting, an original in wax was made, only to be destroyed in the process. The benefit is that extremely fine detail can be reproduced.




This hands-on approach applies to the preparation and installation of our reclaimed flooring as well. Reclaimed floor boards must be de-nailed in a laborious process that cannot be mechanised. Then, each board is prepared and sanded individually to retain the original patina of age.

All our products are made by hand in our own workshops. In this age of mass production and synthetic materials, we are making products to last a lifetime and we think the effort is worthwhile.

I hope you find this catalogue a useful resource in choosing your new bathroom or items of door furniture. Indeed, I hope you are encouraged to visit our showrooms to view samples of our reclaimed flooring and architectural antiques as well.

Wood and stone flooring and installation

Drummonds offers a complete flooring service using the very best reclaimed timber, stone and tiles. Large, covered stores ensure supplies are available of different batches of old oak, pine, parquet de Versailles and other woods, some dating back to the 18th century which are purchased as available.

Antique handmade tiles, limestone flags, Yorkstone, various sizes of more formal limestone and slate cabouchon floors, and other reclaimed stone are also purchased as available. Large sample panels of both timber and stone flooring are displayed in the showrooms.

Fully equipped workshops enable timber to be prepared to customers' exact requirements, including tongue and groove, thickening and edging. All reclaimed boards are prepared and sanded by hand to maintain their original beauty and patina. Drummonds' vacuum kiln enables timber to be dried to specific moisture content as required.

Additionally, Drummonds has available a number of skirting and architrave styles to finish your new floor to perfection and custom profiles can be prepared as required.

Its in-house team of experienced floor layers is able to create the most beautiful results with the floor of your choice.



All Drummonds' reclaimed wood flooring is prepared to client's specifications in our own workshops and laid by our highly experienced floorlayers to create the most beautiful results, as shown here with our 20th century oak.

Original 17th and 18th century oak

17th and 18th century oak flooring with original or smooth surface.

Aged 20th century oak flooring, tongue and groove.

Widths: 180mm, 230mm and 280mm
Thickness: 22mm

Each individual floorboard is hand sanded to the desired finish and prepared to the exact thickness required. Drummonds also offer an edge preparation service to include straight edge, tongue and groove or lapping.



Like all Drummonds' floors, our parquet de Versailles flooring is offered with varying degrees of antiquity, creating a warm, natural beauty, as shown here.

Parquet de Versailles flooring is handmade using 18th century oak.

Large: 980mm x 908mm panels **£220 per panel**
Thickness: 30mm

Small: 750mm x 750mm panels **£160 per panel**
Thickness: 25mm

Parquet de Versailles border fillets

Border fillets are installed between each panel which gives an authentic finish.

Large: £16 per border

Small: £14 per border

All reclaimed pine is hand sanded and ready to lay.

Rustic beam oak

Rustic beam oak flooring.
Thicknesses: 19mm/22mm normal thickness and 12mm.

19/22mm thickness: £176 per sq/m

12mm thickness: £139 per sq/m




Limestone and slate cabouchons

Polished limestone

Our limestone has a smooth surface with hand cut edges. Suitable for internal use and comes in random sizes and thicknesses of about 22mm – 30mm thick.

English yorkstone flags

We source our English yorkstone from gardens and pavements, some of which can be used as interior flagstones. All our yorkstone is oil free.

Cobbles

We normally hold stocks of pink granite, yorkstone sets and cobbles with clean surfaces and in regular sizes, which are ideal for courtyards, driveways or as edging stones.

CARE FOR YOUR DRUMMONDS PRODUCTS

Vitreous enamel cast iron bath

Drummonds cast iron baths are the only new baths on the market today that are enamelled using the traditional vitreous dry frit (powdered glass) process. The resultant enamel is incredibly hard and durable and approximately three times thicker than the wet coated enamel more commonly used today. Drummonds is so confident that one of our baths will last you a lifetime that each one is supplied with a market leading 25 year guarantee. The guarantee covers manufacturing defects or physical deterioration in the interior enamel finish.

To care for your enamelled bath, clean it regularly using a mild non-abrasive detergent applied with a soft cloth and plenty of water to wash away gritty deposits. Ensure that your taps and shower are properly maintained so that they do not drip; this hampers the build up of dirt and limescale.

If the exterior of your bath is polished, clean it occasionally with a soft cloth and wax it with a pure wax polish.

Brass products

Drummonds brassware products are made using the lost wax process from 100% brass. They have been

individually assembled, hand polished and, if required, plated in chrome or nickel. All Drummonds' brassware products are supplied with a 1 year guarantee against manufacturing defects and physical deterioration in the exterior plated finish.

Never use abrasive cleaning materials on brassware. Use a mild non-abrasive bathroom cleaner. For stubborn stains, particularly in hard water areas, lightly apply a proprietary nickel/chrome cleaner.

China sanitaryware

As with the other products in the Drummonds range, china sanitaryware is handmade using the finest materials to give a classic quality finish. All china sanitaryware products are supplied with a 1 year guarantee against manufacturing defects and physical deterioration in the glazed finish.

When cleaning, use any proprietary bathroom cleaner.


Installation

Drummonds' products should be installed by a qualified plumber in accordance with water regulations. Any questions about installation should be directed to the technical support line on 01428 609444.


