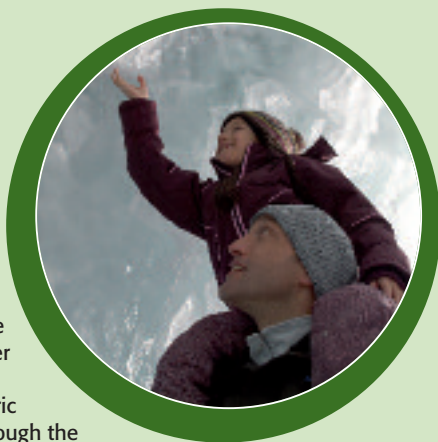

### Gorge Adventure – Rope route through the Gorners Gorge

The Gorners gorge, with its swirling masses of thunderous water, can be traversed downwards for about 1 km in about 3 to 4 hours. The dynamic fixed rope route leads across natural rock formation with climbing aids securely fastened to the cliff. The highlights of the route are three roping stations, three ropeways (the longest approx. 80 meters), a pendulum and Himalaya bridges that give climbers that special adrenaline buzz. Climbers are secured during the entire route and make it to the finish dry shod. The route may only be taken with specialized mountain guides familiar with the region. From age 12.
