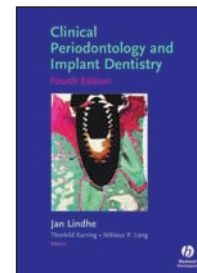

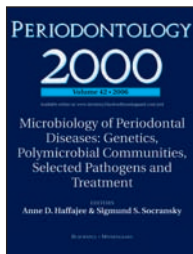

### Practical Periodontal Plastic Surgery

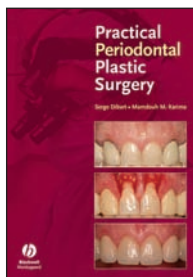
