Set on the day the author arrived home after a three-month tour of the United States promoting his first book, **A Day in Tuscany** compels readers to experience this enchanted corner of Italy through the heart and mind of a true Tuscan. As Castagno sees his beloved hills with fresh eyes and reacquaints himself with the rhythms of home, a flood of recollections of its people and places comes to him. Through his engaging narrative, we are transported as well.

The sights he sees and people he meets as he takes a one-mile walk through his village during the course of this day trigger memories of his childhood and adolescence in Tuscany during the seventies, his experiences as a tour guide in Chianti, and some of the more remarkable people he has known. In addition to stories from his own past, included are oral histories from several village elders.

History and the present mingle in this part of the world, and these stories bring both alive. Sometimes funny, often poignant, **A Day in Tuscany** weaves a magical spell and offers a candid insider's look at the people and culture of a fascinating land.

He has already done every kind of casual labor available, including pirating in San Francisco Bay. So he decides to try his luck. On July 25, 1897, he boards a ship bound for Alaska.

After a winter in the Grand North, London returns, sick with scurvy, to San Francisco with \$4.50 worth of gold dust but a wealth of stories to tell. Eventually *The Call of the Wild* is published; its huge success marking the beginning of a fortune made in the Klondike without pick or pan.

Full-color photographs, ephemera, and excerpts from London's stories are our traveling companions on this journey to the Klondike. Along the way we meet the trappers, Indians, dog team drivers, missionaries, and prospectors that so fascinated and inspired this revered American writer.
