
STUDIO ITALIANOAn Italian Course for Beginners

The aim of this book is to give students a strong basis for learning to speak, understand, read and write modern Italian while at the same time introducing them to the Italian culture. The student learns the language through nursery rhymes, reviews, conversation, games and well-known fables, as well as, through regular readings and grammar exercises. In particular, repetition and review are emphasized as essential tools for learning a new language. There are four readings for each regular chapter: an introductory dialogue (a love story between two students, one Italian and the other American), a Prima Lettura, a Seconda Lettura and L'Italia in miniatura. At the beginning the Letture are just simple dialogues or fables. In the last chapters they gradually become more difficult and, at times, are taken from works of Italian writers. The textbook also includes an appendix with a list of the regular/irregular verbs, an Italian—English/English—Italian vocabulary list and an index. The workbook complements the student book by providing students with additional written and oral exercises. The answers to all the exercises are found at the back of the workbook, while the answers to all the oral questions are given on the CDs.







Progetto Italiano Junior is a course designed for students pre–adolescents and adolescents (11–16 years) as beginners or false beginners.

Progetto Italiano Junior is not merely a copy of **Nuovo Progetto Italiano**. Although it is based on its structure, this course designed for younger learners and respects the learning needs of this age group. Each unit contains a comic story that develops the topic of the unit and tells the story of five young players who accompany the students in the three volumes of this language course. **Progetto Italiano Junior** addresses issues and themes that are familiar to students by exposing them to everyday language and socio—cultural Italian presented through exciting stories in comics. - ◆ There are quizzes and games to explore issues and aspects of the lives of young people and to enhance and reuse frequently used vocabulary
- ◆ A full grammar appendix at the end of each volume addresses all aspects of studied grammar

There is also bilingual version of of student book 1. All instructions and grammatical notes are in English and there is also an English glossary included in the book. The content and structure of the course is identical to the monolingual version, and includes exercise chapters and a CD.
